

NO MUSS NO FUSS SELLERS

Sellers with all white tickets AND a seller number between 100-300 have the privilege of using our NO MUSS NO FUSS EXPRESS

All items must be tagged with WHITE PRICE TICKETS.

Drop your items at the NO MUSS, NO FUSS Express table on RECEIVING day.

Any items we cannot accept for the sale will be donated to charity.

Any items that do not sell on sale days will also be donated to charity.

Bring a self-addressed, stamped envelope to RECEIVING and your check will be mailed to you. You will NOT receive your ticket stubs or any accounting of unsold clothing donated to charity. NO EXCEPTIONS!

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

OUTDOOR EQUIPMENT ACCEPTED:

- Fisher Price, Little Tykes, Step 2, and BICYCLES. Please make sure all outdoor equipment is **clean and in working condition**.
- Equipment with multiple pieces must be secured together (zip ties recommended) or placed in the original box.
- Price ticket should be taped to the item using clear packing tape (NO SCOTCH TAPE) in an obvious location. If multiple pieces cannot be together, each piece should have a price ticket, numbered "Piece 1 of 2 and Piece 2 of 2". Price should be indicated on one ticket only.

DVDS, MUSICAL CDS:

- DVDS AND MUSICAL CDS should be in their original packaging. If original packaging is broken or unavailable, item can be placed in a Ziploc bag, sealed, or wrapped with plastic wrap.
- Price ticket should be placed on the outside of the bag or plastic wrap, using clear packing tape (NO SCOTCH TAPE). Tape the LEFT side of the price ticket, leaving the perforation exposed.
- NO VIDEOS OR BOOKS ARE ACCEPTED

BABY FURNITURE, EQUIPMENT AND CAR RESTRAINTS

- Baby cribs, car seats/booster seats, high chairs, bouncy seats etc. should be **clean and in working condition**.
- Car seats and Booster seats must be **no more** than 5 years old. We can only accept car seats manufactured in the year 2006-2011.
- Equipment with multiple pieces must be secured together (zip ties recommended) or placed in the original box.
- Due to space constraints, please bring cribs disassembled, if possible. We recommend bringing a photo of the assembled item and attaching it near the price ticket.
- Price ticket should be taped to the item using clear packing tape (**NO SCOTCH TAPE**) in an obvious location. If multiple pieces cannot be together, each piece should have a price ticket, numbered "Piece 1 of 2 and Piece 2 of 2".
- **Price should be indicated on one ticket only.**

Your support and participation in the 25th annual GRE PTA Clothing Sale is very appreciated! The clothing sale is a consignment sale of clean, top-quality, new and used children's clothing, cribs, baby equipment, outdoor play equipment, and videos. Acceptable clothing sizes are Boys 0-20 and Girls 0-16.

The consignment payment is a 70% seller, 30% GRE PTA split on all items. The 30% is tax deductible for the seller!

Excluded items include toys, books, wall art, linens, bedding, quilts, bumper pads, beds, bath tubs, underwear and swim suits.

Seller Number:

Your seller number, printed in the box above, is your identification number throughout the sale. It will be used to calculate your sales earnings (payment), to address your payment check and claim your unsold items.

IMPORTANT DATES

RECEIVING DATES:

Thursday, September 17, 2011 8am – 7pm
Friday, September 16, 2011 8am – 11am

We ask that you wait while your items are being received, so that we can return any unacceptable items back to you.

TICKET INFORMATION

Sellers will be limited to 100 tickets. Therefore we ask that you select your best items for the GRE PTA Clothing Sale. We provide two types of tickets, as indicated below. Please return any unused tickets to RECEIVING.

GREEN TICKETS: used for items being sold at FULL PRICE the entire sale. Unsold items will be returned to seller, available for pickup on Sunday. Any items not picked by 6pm on Sunday will be donated to charity.

WHITE TICKETS: used for items being sold at **FULL PRICE on Saturday, HALF PRICE on Sunday.** *WHITE TICKET items not sold will NOT be returned to sellers. All UNSOLD WHITE TICKET items will be donated to charity.*

FILLING OUT TICKETS:

For your protection, we request you complete your tickets in BLUE or BLACK ink and DO NOT cross out or write over errors, instead complete a new ticket. Please double check each ticket to make sure it has the following information.

1. Your Seller # on BOTH sides of the ticket.
2. Boy/Girl – circle one on BOTH sides of the ticket.
3. Item – Pants, Overalls, PJ's, dress, shirt, etc. Write on BOTH sides of the ticket.
4. Size – Use a number size only, including slim or regular. DO NOT use S / M / L, even if that is how the item was originally sized. Refer to the size chart below.
5. Description – Brand, colors, pattern, etc.
6. Seller name – Your initials or last name.
7. Price – On BOTH sides of the ticket.

Size Categories

Newborn (NB), 3 mos., 9 mos., 12 mos., 18 mos., 24 mos., 2T thru 5T,
2 thru 6, 6X, 7 thru 16 (Girls), 7 thru 20 (Boys)

Conversion Chart for Boy's Pants

Waist 24=Size 10 Waist 26=Size 14 Waist 28=Size 18
Waist 25=Size 12 Waist 27=Size 16 Waist 29=Size 20

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PRICING:

A good rule of thumb to use when pricing is 25% of the original purchase price. **All prices must be in .50 cent increments with \$.50 being the minimum price.** Do not overprice items you really want to sell.

RECEIVING INFORMATION:

Items will be accepted by RECEIVING only if in excellent condition: CLEAN, PRESSED (when necessary), PROPERLY HUNG, and TICKETED. RECEIVING cannot accept items that are:

- * OUTDATED
- * STAINED OR TORN
- * MISSING BUTTONS
- * EXCESSIVE PET HAIR
- * HAVE BROKEN ZIPPERS
- * SMELL OF SMOKE
- * HAVE EXCESSIVE PILLING

DISPLAYING GARMENTS:

Use a 1" or larger safety pin to pin the price ticket(s) on the garment. Pin tickets just to the left of the perforated line. Tickets are to be placed in the upper left side of the garment, as you wear it, whether the item is hung or folded. See diagram below.

Hangers must be wire or unbreakable plastic. The hook of the hanger should face the right shoulder, away from the ticket. Use safety pins to secure 2-piece garments together.

- *Dresses
- *Skirts & Skirt Sets
- *Uniforms
- *Blouses
- *Robes
- *Costumes
- *Dress Shirts
- *Coats/Jackets
- *PJ's (4T-14)

FOLDED ITEMS

- *Pants
- *Knit Shirts
- *Shorts
- *Sweatshirts
- *Sweaters
- *PJ's (Infant – 3T)

SHOES:

The seller number and price should be written directly on the sole of the shoe or on a piece of masking tape. The tape should be affixed to the bottom of each shoe. In addition, all shoes must be zip tied together and a completed sales ticket attached to each pair of shoes.

ALL SHOES WILL BE MARKED ½ PRICE ON SUNDAY
UNSOLED SHOES WILL BE DONATED TO CHARITY
UNSOLED SHOES WILL NOT BE RETURNED TO THE SELLER

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
