Carnival – April 30, 2010 – A family fun-filled evening when our GRE Community comes together and transforms the school into a Carnival! This event is a great opportunity for teenagers to get volunteer hours as well as all the families of GRE to make the evening FUN and successful. Volunteers are needed to assist with set up, clean up and managing the game booths.

Food Court at the Carnival – Meals Deals, sweet drinks and treats are available during the Carnival. Lots of helpers are needed to feed those hungry game players!

Clothing Sale – October 15-17, 2009 – Watch for a special Clothing Sale flyer providing details of times and job descriptions to be distributed after school begins. The funds raised at this event fund the general line item portion of the PTA's budget. This is the largest, annual fundraiser the PTA coordinates and we need all the helping hands we can get!

Girl Event Dance – February 26, 2010 – A special evening reserved for that special guy in a GRE Girls' life and a female student for dancing, laughing, bonding and friendships.

Hand in Hand – Various events throughout school year – This committee is responsible for determining ways in which GRE can reach out to the community through various "donation" projects.

Hospitality - Various events throughout school year – This committee is responsible for arranging special meals for the GRE Staff throughout the school year, such as Fall Conferences and Teacher Appreciation Week.

- **School year opportunities** – Assisting the Librarian with various tasks, such as shelving books assisting students and helping with special projects as directed from the Librarian.
- **Visiting Authors** – Committee is responsible for the publicity of author visits, sale of author books and transportation for visiting authors.
- **Recycled Book Sale – Spring 2010** – Donated books are collected from the community and sold to the students and community as a fundraiser for the library. Volunteers are allowed to select two adult books as a thank you for their volunteer efforts.

Boy Event – November 6, 2009 – A special evening reserved for that special lady in a GRE Boy's life and a male student for fun, laughter, and friendships.

PALS (Parents As Literacy Support) – School year commitment – Volunteers work approximately 1 hour per week assisting students who need extra help in areas of reading and writing.

Parent Enrichment – This committee schedules speakers that will help enhance and enrich parenting. Events are scheduled at GRE throughout the school year. A valuable committee designed to give opportunities to the parents of GRE.

Red Ribbon Week – October 26-30, 2009 – This national drug awareness week program is sponsored by the DEA. Volunteers assist with educating the students about the importance of being drug free by helping with “spirit days”, a helicopter fly-in, speakers and other fun, impacting events.

Reflections – October 2009, with a Theme of “Beauty Is....” – This a Colorado originated, National PTA sponsored cultural arts project. Volunteers help organize publicity, entries and competition at the local level.

Room Parent Coordinator – School Year Commitment – Volunteer needed to coordinate each teacher’s Room Parent volunteers for class parties, teacher birthdays and teacher appreciation week. Room Parent Coordinator compiles and distributes folders to the Room Parents and sends reminders for upcoming classroom parties.

Senior Breakfast – May 26, 2010 – This popular breakfast honors former GRE students graduating from high school. Graduating Seniors are invited to GRE to “visit” the school, take a trip down memory lane and catch up with former teachers.

Science Fair – March 25-26, 2010 – Volunteers help coordinate informational flyers, publicity, rules booklets, registration forms, judges, awards and award ceremony.

Spaghetti Dinner – March 25, 2010 - Volunteer needed to coordinate a pasta dinner during the Science Fair in an effort to bring the GRE Community together to eat dinner together and view the science fair projects.

Silent Auction – Spring 2011 – The second largest fundraising event hosted by the GRE PTA. This profitable event is organized to fund the ExCEL portion of the PTA budget with monies raised intended to support a two-year budget. Many volunteers are needed to make this event successful and provide much needed curriculum - enhancing dollars to our budget.

Talent Show – May 20, 2010 – Students showcase their interests, activities, and talents in a spectacular show, usually scheduled during the last week of school. Auditions are held several weeks beforehand and many volunteers are needed to help the kids “strut their stuff”! Due to overwhelming participation, this is planned to be an evening affair this year.

Yearbook – This committee is responsible for assembling the yearbook. As always, these volunteers are looking for individuals to donate pictures of students during the school year. Take pictures whenever you attend a classroom party, activity or special event. Communications will be distributed later in the school year notifying where to send the photos.
